Established TifTuf Bermuda lawn • Fruit-bearing landscape border • Continued seasonal fill-in

3" x 3" TifTuf plugs

3 years of fill-in

Weed control + steady spread



Plug-grown TifTuf Bermuda lawn

Entire backyard established from plugs and still thickening each warm season.

Lawn establishment

This backyard lawn was grown entirely from 3" x 3" TifTuf Bermuda plugs over the last 3 years.

The approach has been simple: stay ahead of weeds and let the Bermuda spread aggressively during the growing season.

Any bare spots visible today are part of that active fill-in and continue tightening as temperatures rise.

Why TifTuf Bermuda

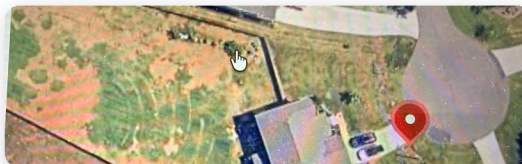
- Excellent drought tolerance for sunny lawns
- Dense, fine-textured turf with a clean look
- Strong recovery and lateral spread in full sun

Chosen for a warm, open backyard where long-term spread matters.

Clay-friendly maintenance

Grass clippings are intentionally returned to the lawn and spread over the dense clay surface. As they break down, they add organic matter, help condition the soil, and encourage continued Bermuda spread.

Fruit-bearing landscape border

Plantings are labeled left to right to help visitors understand what is already established in the backyard.



Fruit-bearing plantings (left to right): Fuji apple tree, Granny Smith apple tree, 2 blueberry bushes, and an established NC raspberry colony that regrows after seasonal cutback. All are fruit-bearing varieties intended for productive harvests.
