Re: Annual Dues Increase and Special Assessment Notification

On January 7, 2026, the Stonehenge XI Homeowners' Association, Inc. (Bridgeport Homeowners' Association) voted to elect a new Board of Directors, comprised of:
Chelsea Kelly, President
Paul Connors, Vice President
Michale Murdock, Treasurer
Luke Sherry, Secretary

and to approve:

- (i) an increase in the annual dues by \$535 from \$665 to \$1,200 per year, and
- (ii) a Special Assessment to be paid entirely into the Roads Reserve Fund (RRF) in the amount of \$743, as a one-time assessment for 2026.
- (iii) a 2026 annual budget as presented

Four checking or savings funds will be established as follows. **These four funds will be independently maintained, with individual bank accounts, and no commingling of funds.**

- (1) Operation and Maintenance (OM) Fund,
- (2) Irrigation system Fund (ISF),
- (3) Road Reserve Fund (RRF), and
- (4) Contingency Fund (CF).

As discussed, the dues increase to \$1,200 currently allots \$900 (75% of the dues) to OM, \$150 to RRF, and \$150 to ISF (25% to be split between the ISF and the RRF) per household. The CF is funded from the OM budget dues allocation at a rate of \$83 per household. Unused ISF and CF funds at the end of the calendar year will revert to the Road Reserve Fund.

As explained at the previous Association meetings and correspondence, the Special Assessment will be used to ensure the appropriate balances are maintained in the RRF for expected future road and utility infrastructure repair. Additionally, increasing the dues to a sufficient level allows the Board to fund the operations of the neighborhood (through the OM), as well as the establish the ISF and CF for future repairs as they arise. This memorandum explains how and when the annual dues and Assessment must be paid.

Annual Dues: The 2026 annual dues and Special Assessment one-time fee for the Association are \$1,200.00. This fee can be paid per the agenda options noted below. Annual dues thereafter are due on or before February 7th of each year.
