

According to public information available to us, 810 Firebrick Drive, Cary, NC (Zip Code 27519, though typed as 28519) **is not located within a Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA).**

Official geospatial mapping records place this specific lot in the **Brickyard community**, which falls under **Zone X**. This designation indicates an area of minimal flood hazard, situated entirely outside both the 100-year and 500-year floodplains.

Because it is in a low-risk zone, federal law does not mandate flood insurance for properties with a mortgage at this address.

- **Local County Mapping:** Use the [Wake County iMAPS GIS Tool](#) to cross-reference the exact property boundaries with any historical flood soils or local municipal drainage basins.
- **Town-Specific Review:** You can issue an official reading request through the [Town of Cary Floodplain Management Portal](#) via their 311 service to check for town-regulated buffers or stream sensor networks nearby.
